On the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Department of Constitutional Law of Tashkent State Law University will hold an international scientific and practical conference on the topic **“Formation of modern constitutionalism in Uzbekistan: achievements, challenges and prospects”** on December 1, 2022, and prepare a **scientific collection** in electronic form based on its materials.

Articles on topical issues and scientific problems in the following areas can be submitted for the scientific collection:

1. The role of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan as the main law, its improvement and application.
2. Constitutional foundations of human rights.
3. Constitutional issues of regulation of society and individual relations.
4. Constitutional foundations of state authorities.

The materials will be formed in the form of a scientific collection in December 2022. In this regard, you can send an article in electronic form in Uzbek, Russian or English until November 30, 2022. Abstracts and articles published in the collection of conferences will be indexed in the international database **GoogleScholar (Google Academy)** and have **DOI**.

**Articles must meet the following requirements:**

1. The text should be 3-5 pages long.
2. In the text editor Word in Times New Roman font, 14 pt, 1 intervals, paper size A 4 210 x 197 mm; text area 2 cm top and bottom, 1.5 cm right, 3 cm left.

3. The title of the article is written in capital letters and in bold, on the next line the surname, name of the author, place of work, academic degree and title, position, name of the educational institution, telephone number, email address are indicated.

4. **Abstract** of the article is required

5. The article must also contain **keywords (at least 7)**.

6. The literature used should **be at least 3-4 items**.

7. References to the article (footnotes) are made in the form [1,2, ...] and at the end of the article in the column "Literature used" are indicated as a link in the order of the reference numbers.

8. The author is responsible for the reliability, correctness and absence of plagiarism in the article.

9. Articles that are not related to the topic, unedited and presented with spelling errors, are not included in the scientific collection.

**Note:** Articles are accepted **until November 30, 2022**.
